

Washington, D.C. Trip

Brethren... On March 11-13, 2024, the Grand Master of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of North Carolina and the Sovereign Grand Inspector General of the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite in North Carolina will be traveling by train with recently raised Master Masons and 32nd Degree Scottish Rite Masters of the Royal Secret to our nation's capital for a tour of the George Washington National Masonic Memorial and the Scottish Rite House of the Temple. They plan to attend a Scottish Rite Ceremony of Remembrance and Renewal hosted by the Valley of Washington, Orient of the District of Columbia. The trip on the train will allow Brethren to meet one another and explore answers to our questions about freemasonry with a focus on the acceptance of our newest members of the Craft. For those already scheduled to attend, please bring money for food, Metro, and any other things you wish to purchase.

Anyone else interested in joining them for this trip at your own expense is welcome to do so. You may travel by train if there are seats to Alexandria on the Carolinian 80 on March 11th. They will be returning to North Carolina on March 13th on the Carolinian 79. If you'd like to travel by train and join the group, you are encouraged to book early; they have twenty people booked in business class already! The dress code on both days is casual. On Tuesday morning, March 12th, they plan to walk to the George Washington National Masonic Monument in the morning, have lunch in either Alexandria or D.C. (a train conversation), catch the Metro to visit the House of the Temple in the afternoon, attend the Valley of Washington's Ceremony of Remembrance and Renewal with dinner, and return by Metro to Alexandria. The dress code on Tuesday is "coat and tie, wearing comfortable shoes."

There may be still time to book a room at the Hampton in Alexandria, where we are staying. The rate is \$229 per night plus tax, including breakfast. Breakfast is served daily from 6 am-10 am. If needed, parking is an additional fee of \$20 per night. https://group.hamptoninn.com/w6yzow
