

## The George Washington National Masonic Memorial

On February 22, 1910, Virginia's Grand Master, Joseph W. The Memorial, conceived as a symbolic lighthouse, was approved a decade later, situated on a hill in Alexandria familiar to Washington himself.


## The House of the Temple
